

**GWENT GOLF UNION**  
**JUNIOR INTER CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP RULES 2023**

The Gwent Junior Inter Club Championship will take place at the end of each season between Gwent clubs who have expressed a wish to play in this championship and notified the Honorary Secretary.

The teams will play 18 holes of medal stroke play under the following conditions:

- 1) Each club to field a team of 6 players (Girls and Boys)  
Boys to play from the Mens Competition Tees (White)  
Girls to play from the Ladies Competition Tees (Red)  
Maximum Handicap Index = 24
- 2) Caddies are not allowed
- 3) An aggregate of 5 cards to count:  
Best Gross Score  
Plus four best net scores
- 4) The winning team will be the team with lowest combined aggregate of the best gross and 4 best net scores.
- 5) In the event of a tie then the net score of the discarded 6th card will be counted, and if further tied then a card count back of the discarded 6<sup>th</sup> card will take place; i.e. back 9, 6, 3, 1. In the event of a further tie then the winners will be decided by lot.

The winners will go forward to represent Gwent in the Welsh Junior Inter Club Championship.
