### GWENT GOLF UNION STROKE PLAY CHAMPIONSHIP

#### **TERMS OF THE COMPETITION**

- 1. Competitors must be:
  - a) A person of amateur status as defined by the Royal & Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews.
  - b) A playing member or a Secretary of an affiliated club of the Union or must have been born in the county and be a member of an affiliated club in another county.
  - c) Must not have taken part in a golf championship of another county since January of the previous year.
- 2. The Championship shall be played over 2 rounds of 18 holes each, which shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews and with the Local Rules approved by the Championship Committee. Failure to complete the 2 rounds will result in disciplinary action being taken against the player, and will include ineligibility to compete in the championship the following year.
- 3. Players shall start at the time laid down by the Committee (Rule 5-3a). However it is a condition of this Championship that, if the player arrives at his starting point, ready to play, within 5 minutes after his starting time, in the absence of circumstances which warrant waiving the penalty of disqualification as provided in Rule 5-3a, the penalty for failure to start on time is 2 strokes at the first hole instead of disqualification.

The Championship Committee reserve the right to fix and/or alter starting times.

Starting Times will be posted on the GGU website and supplied to all Club Secretaries and the South Wales Argus.

- 4. The Champion shall be the competitor who returns the lowest gross score for 36 holes. A tie will be decided on aggregate stroke play over three extra holes selected by the Championship Committee. If there is still a tie, a hole by hole play off will take place. In the event of ties, other than the championship the 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> places will be decided on count back.
- 5. The Champion will hold the Championship Cup for one year and receive a memento.
- 6. Overall Gross Prize Vouchers:- 1<sup>st</sup> £300 2<sup>nd</sup> £200 3<sup>rd</sup> £150 a.m./p.m. Best Gross Vouchers £50 each a.m./p.m. Best Net Vouchers £50 each
- 7. No winner to win more than one prize in the a.m Gross/Net or in the p.m. Gross/Net.
- 8. The Championship Committee will adjudicate on all matters needing a decision and their ruling shall be final.

#### **ENTRIES**

- 1. Entries shall be made on the special Entry Form which is obtainable from Club Secretaries and the Gwent Golf Union website. Entries will only be accepted from players whose handicap index does not exceed 9 strokes under the WHS.
- 2. The Championship will be limited to 60 competitors. In the event of applications exceeding this number, entries for the higher handicap competitors shall be decided by ballot, which shall take place immediately after the closing date for entries. All unsuccessful entrants will be informed without delay thereafter, but will be given the opportunity to compete if scratchings subsequently occur. Entrance fees will be refunded to entrants balloted out and who do not compete. The exact handicap index at the date of entry will be used for all purposes.

#### **DRESS**

Competitors must conform to a standard of dress required by the host club both on and off the course. Failure to do so could result in a player being asked to leave the course and subsequent disqualification from the Championship.

#### SUSPENSION of PLAY

In the event of adverse conditions affecting play a klaxon will be sounded:

One prolonged note of siren.

Three consecutive notes of siren, repeated.

Two short notes of siren, repeated.
