TERMS OF THE CHAMPIONSHIP

ENTRY

A competitor must be under 18 years of age on the 1st January of the Championship year to qualify for the U18 Championship.

A competitor must be under 16 years of age on the 1st January of the Championship year to qualify for the U16 Championship.

A competitor must be under 14 years of age on the 1st January of the Championship year to qualify for the U14 Championship.

The U14 Championship will be played over 18 holes.

Note: U14 and U16 players are eligible for the U16 and U18 Championship.

If the Championship is oversubscribed then a ballot of the highest handicap index competitors in each age group will take place immediately after the closing date for entries. The handicap index submitted at the time of entry will be used. All unsuccessful entrants will be notified without delay thereafter, but will be given the opportunity to compete if scratchings subsequently occur.

START TIMES

A full list of start times will be provided if a SAE is included with the Entry Form otherwise start times can be viewed on the Gwent Golf Union web site.

Rule 5-3a will be applied.

DRESS

Competitors must conform to a standard of dress required by the host club both on and off the course. Failure to do so could result in a player being asked to leave the course and subsequent disqualification from the Championship.

CADDIES

Caddies are not allowed in the Championship, except in the case of physical disability, and agreement must be sought from the Championship Chairman prior to the commencement of the Championship.

LIABILITY

All competitors are reminded that neither the GGU nor the host club can be held responsible for any personal property. Competitors are advised to arrange their own insurance to include public liability.

NOTE

The GGU request that Parents, Relatives, and Spectators keep an appropriate distance from play at all times and must not communicate with a player.
